

This all day session is aimed specifically at training architects, builders, surveyors, estate agents and other professionals giving advice, undertaking or specifying works to clients whose properties new, or old are, or could be affected by elevated levels of radon and will also be of interest to lending institutions, solicitors and others involved in conveyancing work. This course includes lectures on all aspects of radon remediation including existing and new-build and also includes a lecture on the practical aspects of laying a successful radon membrane/barrier. The overall objective is to raise public and professional awareness about radon and its hazard to health in both the home and workplace we hope that you will find our comprehensive Radon Manual (free to all candidates) of assistance. **Please note that bookings for the above course, together with your cheque for £250 must be received by Monday, 3rd October.
